### 2014 Special Deer Hunt

### **Background Information:**

There have been many concerns and complaints from the citizens of Grand Rapids on the over-population of deer in our community, such as vehicle vs. deer crashes and significant negative impact to adjacent landowner's vegetation. We held a Special Deer Hunt within the city limits of Grand Rapids during the fall hunting season in 2013, with some good success. Upon talking with the Area Wildlife Manager from the State of Minnesota, this Special Deer Hunt should go at least another 1 to 2 more years to make an impact on the deer population we originally set out to do. Perry Loegering, Area Wildlife Manager would like to address the city council on this issue and to answer any questions pertaining to this special deer hunt.

#### **Staff Recommendation:**

The Police Department recommends having another Special Deer Hunt in the City Limits of Grand Rapids with some possible modifications as to where the hunt will occur, possilby only having it in the south end of the city where we have been having the most issues.
