RE: 2012-2016 CIP and 2012 Proposed Infrastructure Projects

Attached is the City's proposed 2012-2016 CIP identifying projects by funding sources.

The projects to focus on now (short-term) are:

- CP 2011-4, Horseshoe-Isleview Partial Reconstruction, which was a 2011 capital improvement project where bonding was delayed to consolidate the MSAS Bonding with CP 2004-3,
- CP-2004-3, 4th Street SW/SE, and
- CP 2011-6, Horseshoe Lake Road Improvements.

All three projects require MSAS Bonding and GO Bonding which will be discussed in further detail. Bonding components for the three projects are summarized in the following table:

MSAS Bonding – The City currently receives approximately \$875,000 in MSAS funds on an annual basis. The City previously issued MSAS Bonds in 2005 and in 2007. The annual payment for both bonds is approximately \$240,000 resulting in \$635,000 in available annual "cash". The 2005 bond issuance will be complete in calendar year 2015, freeing up about an additional \$127,000. The 2007 bond issuance has a longer term expiring in 2022.

City staff is recommending issuing \$4,180,000 in MSAS Bonds for a 15 year term. This will require approximately \$350,000 of our available annual MSAS funds of \$635,000, resulting in a reduction of available "cash" of \$285,000 until calendar year 2016 when the available "cash" would increase by about \$127,000 to a total available cash of \$412,000 on an annual basis.

By issuing MSAS Bonds, the amount of GO Bonds is decreased, thus reducing the amount of increase to the levy to pay for projects.

GO Bonding – At a minimum the City is committed to bonding for CP 2011-4 and CP 2004-3. The question is whether the City should bond for CP 2011-6 in calendar year 2012 or 2013. To assist the council in answering this question, levy increase calculations were generated assuming a 0%_increase in operating expenses and no change in taxable market value or fiscal disparities. The following table summarizes the impacts to the general levy.

Summary of Short-Term Bonding – Part of the funding for 2010-3 19th Avenue Railroad Project (2011 project) was a federal grant for \$875,000, but the funds will not be available until October 1, 2013. We are proposing a Temporary Bond for \$920,000 to bridge that temporary shortfall. That includes \$875,000 par amount of the bonds, capitalized interest of \$22,458, and bond issuing costs of \$22,542. The capitalized interest will be used to pay the interest when the bonds are paid off. If the federal funds are received earlier than anticipated, we can pay off the bonds early, the interest cost will be less, and any capitalized interest funds remaining can be used for another project.

CIP Future Impacts (2013 – 2016) – The total estimate GO Debt that would be required to complete the proposed 2013–2016 of the Five Year CIP is \$12,824,074. On average this equates to \$3,206,018 per year for construction years 2013-2016. This is almost identical to the bond issuance for all three projects discussed earlier in this document at \$3,265,000. So one could expect about 3.4% increase to the levy each year if all projects currently in the CIP were done.
