Statement of Issue:	Consider approval of 2016 Central School leases with: Itasca Area Community Education, Jenna Salmela Photography, ABC's of Quilting, True North Salon and Spa, Lake Lover Trading Company, and ServeMinnesota Action Network.
Background:	In November, Commissioners Jackson and Przytarski and staff met to discuss rental rates for 2016 in light of the current local economy, the status of our extended agreement with Northrock Development, and the present occupancy in Central School. It was agreed to propose leases for 2016 that maintained the 2015 rates, which in fact were rates carried over from 2014. All leases expiring at the end of 2015, with the exception of one, were under the terms of our master lease. Our master lease has a term of one year and has the tenant responsible for property taxes due. The one exception was a lease previously negotiated with ABC's of Quilting for space on the first floor and the garden level. This was a three year lease that had the City paying the tenant's property taxes.
	A goal of GREDA has been to re-establish a consistent/equitable rent structure. The lease proposed to ABC's of Quilting for 2016 followed our current master lease and the combined costs of the first floor and garden level spaces, as well as the projected property taxes, were slightly less than their 2015 rental cost. ABC's, however, decided to not renew their lease for the 389 sf garden level space, which they had been using for storage. This was the only space not renewed under a 2016 lease. Visit Grand Rapids is the only tenant that did not have the term of their lease expiring at the end of the year. Their lease expires on March 31, 2016.
Recommendation:	Approve the leases and authorize the GREDA President to execute them on behalf of GREDA
