CITY OF GRAND RAPIDS HUMAN RIGHTS COMMISSION CONFERENCE ROOM 2B – 420 NORTH POKEGAMA AVENUE WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 30, 2011 – 4:00 P.M.

CALL TO ORDER: Pursuant to due notice and call thereof a regular meeting of the Grand Rapids Human Rights Commission was held in Conference Room 2B of City Hall, 420 North Pokegama Avenue, Grand Rapids, Minnesota, on Wednesday, November 30, 2011, at 4:00 p.m.

CALL OF ROLL: On a Call of Roll, the following members were present: Commissioners: Dowell, Hall, Learmont and Sanderson. Absent: Commissioners Hain, Freeman, Mundt and Wartchow.

As both Chair and Vice Chair were absent, Commission members made the following motion to appoint Commissioner Sanderson as Temporary Chair:

MOTION BY COMMISSIONER HALL, SECOND BY COMMISSIONER LEARMONT TO APPOINT COMMISSIONER BARB SANDERSON TO ACT AS TEMPORARY CHAIR IN THE ABSENCE OF THE CHAIR AND VICE CHAIR. The following voted in favor thereof: Hall, Learmont, Dowell and Sanderson. Opposed: None, motion carried.

- 1. CALL TO ORDER: The meeting was called to order by Temporary Chair Sanderson at 4:00 p.m.
- 2. SETTING OF REGULAR AGENDA:

MOTION BY COMMISSIONER LEARMONT, SECOND BY COMMISSIONER HALL TO APPROVE THE AGENDA AS PRESENTED. The following voted in favor thereof: Learmont, Hall, Dowell and Sanderson. Opposed: None, motion passed.

3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES: October 26, 2011 regular meeting

Commissioner Hall noted she was present in the call of roll rather than Commissioner Hain. Therefore, the following motion was made:

MOTION BY COMMISSIONER DOWELL, SECOND BY COMMISSIONER LEARMONT TO APPROVE THE MINUTES OF OCTOBER 26, 2011 WITH THE CORRECTION IN THE CALL OF ROLL CORRECTED TO READ COMMISSIONER HALL PRESENT RATHER THAN COMMISSIONER HAIN. The following voted in favor thereof: Dowell, Learmont, Hall and Sanderson. Opposed: None, motion passed.

- 5. **PUBLIC COMMENT:** Nothing to report.

6. OLD BUSINESS:

a. Accessibility Project Grant Monies.

Human Resources Director Lynn DeGrio arranged for Mike Rice, Building Inspector to put together an ADA educational pamphlet to be handed out to any business remodel project or any new businesses who come in for a permit. All will be printed and invoiced by December 31, 2011.

Commissioner Sanderson will ask Chair Wartchow to write the final follow up letter to Blandin regarding the grant.

b. Hate/Bias Crime Response Plan Follow Up.

Commissioners approved of the City of Grand Rapids Hate and Bias Crime Response Plan. Commissioner Sanderson will write a cover letter to Chief of Police Jim Denny and copy the City Administrator Shawn Gillen. The letter will ask Chief Denny to review the plan and then the Human Rights Commission will set up a meeting.

c. Lobbying - 2012 Constitutional Amendment - ACC Meeting Report.

Commissioner Sanderson reported on the college meeting to set up a panel to discuss the pros and cons of the amendment. ICC stated they will cover expenses. The Human Rights Commission has been asked to co-sponsor the event with Commissioner Sanderson facilitating the discussion. Suggested panelists were: Human Rights Commissioner, judge (viewpoint from law aspect), OutFront Minnesota or new committee, ministers pro and con and possibly American Indian perspective. After discussion, a motion was made to co-sponsor the event:

MOTION BY COMMISSIONER HALL, SECOND BY COMMISSIONER DOWELL TO CO-SPONSOR WITH ICC FOR THE UPCOMING PANELIST DISCUSSION CONCERNING THE 2012 CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT. The following voted in favor thereof: Hall, Dowell, Learmont and Sanderson. Opposed: None, motion passed.

d. Historical Trauma Report on November 2 Meeting.

Commissioners Sanderson and Freeman attended the meeting November 2, 2011. Commissioner Sanderson stated the group was still in the talking stages. Question asked for consideration at that meeting, what can this group do that no one else has done? Next meeting will be held Friday, December 9 in Deer River from 3:00-6:00 p.m.; location to be determined. All Commissioners interested are invited to attend.

7. NEW BUSINESS:

a. Request from MN Department of Human Rights.

Commissioners were not aware of any annual report which the MN Department of Human Rights were requesting if they had one. Commissioners also discussed changes within the MN Department of Human Rights and concerns with quality in handling cases more quickly with only four intake officers. A special meeting could be arranged with the MN Department of Human Rights.
