**LIGHT FIXTURES**

All new and replacement fixtures will be either 40 or 70 watt LED lamps. All other fixture types shall be changed to 40 or 70 watt LED lamps with customer charges adjusted at that time.

Mercury Vapor Lamps: Will not be installed or replaced. All 7,000 lumen 175 watt mercury vapor lamps will be changed out to a 40 watt LED fixture and billed at the applicable rate plus any applicable adjustments.

**SERVICE AREA:** Applicable to all service areas at the GRPUC.

**APPLICATION:** To all classes of customers for outdoor lighting purposes and to other persons and Governmental subdivisions other than the City of Grand Rapids for the purpose of lighting streets, alleys, roads, driveways and parking lots. Service under the rate codes is not available on a seasonal or temporary basis.

**ADJUSTMENTS:** Plus the applicable proportionate part of any taxes and assessments imposed by any governmental authority which are assessed on the basis of meters or customers, or the price of or revenues from electric energy or service sold, or the volume of energy generated, transmitted or purchased for sale or sold.
