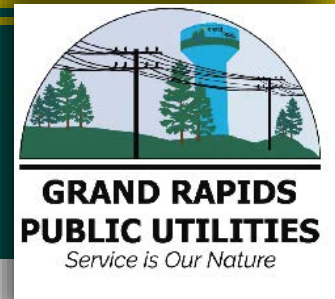


# Grand Rapids Public Utilities Residential Home Energy Audit Program

- Report delivered to you with the recommendations discussed on site.

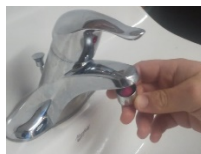
## Home Walkthrough with Blower Door Test and Infrared Scan - \$50

If your primary heat source is electricity, then you will also be eligible for a blower door test and walkthrough with an infrared camera. This will allow for:

- A better idea of what is happening behind your drywall and areas that can't be seen
- A view of temperature differences to see where insulation is present, missing or ineffective
- Development of more customized solutions to address air leaks, ice dams and overall conditioned air loss
- Any notable findings from each analysis will be included in the audit report that gets delivered to you.

## Direct Install Options (Dependent Upon Heating Source)

While on site, the auditor will install up to three LED screw-in bulbs at the location of your choice. If you have an electric water heater, the direct install may also include up to two high efficiency showerheads, two faucet aerators, and assess/make an adjustment to the water heater set point temperature. If your primary heat source is electricity, the direct install may also include new foam weather stripping around exterior doors and electrical outlet insulation gaskets for exterior wall outlets and switches.
