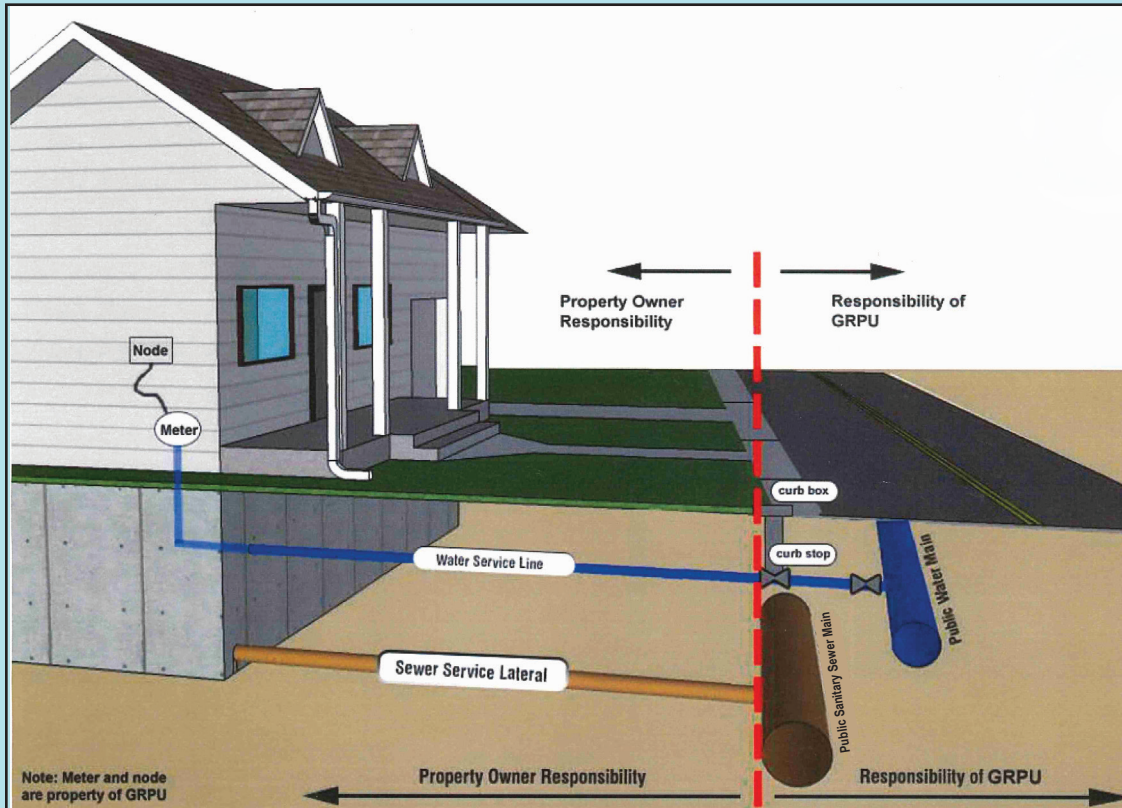


— Water & Sanitary Sewer Lines —

What Property Owners Should Know

Private property owners are responsible for the maintenance and repairs of the water line from their property up to the curb stop, unless otherwise specified in the customer's service agreement. The water meter and the water node are property of Grand Rapids Public Utilities (GRPU) on the service line.

Private property owners are responsible for the maintenance and repairs of sanitary sewer components from their property up to and including the connection to the public sanitary sewer main unless otherwise specified in the customer's service agreement.



Service line repairs can be costly

Replace water service line (26-100 ft.)
Avg. Repair Cost **\$2,661***

Replace sanitary sewer line (26-75 ft.)
Avg. Repair Cost **\$5,054***

SLWA service plans are available for:

- Exterior Water Service Line Coverage
- Exterior Sewer/Septic Line Coverage
- Interior Plumbing and Drainage System Coverage

WHO CAN HELP?

If your homeowner's insurance policy does not cover service lines, home repair plans are available through Service Line Warranties of America (SLWA). SLWA plans are endorsed by the National League of Cities and the GRPU. The plans are completely optional and it is up to the homeowner to decide if a plan is beneficial to them based on their personal circumstances.
